




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Values - Proposed

- Promote impartial treatment amongst stakeholders and constituents of NIVS






Strategic Direction for Transformation: 2023-2025

NIVS Strategy 2023 – 2025





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Modernize Suriname's Food Safety Legislation and Develop Supporting Regulatory Frameworks

Activities:

- 1.1 Develop and consult on policy underpinning the new food safety legislation.
- 1.2 Draft a modernized Suriname Food Act and support its discussion and adoption by Parliament.
- 1.3 Develop a regulatory regime for food import management and control.
- 1.4 Develop a regulatory regime for minimum food safety requirements of Food Business Operators.
- 1.5 Develop Updated Food Safety Standards and other Horizontal Food Regulatory Requirements.



Promote Food Safety Practices by Surinamese Food Producers and Operators

- Activities:
- 2.1 Develop tailored guidance for enhanced food safety practices for food producers.
- 2.2 Develop and deploy guidance and associated training on Good Agriculture Practice (GAP) adapted for Suriname.
- 2.3 Develop a general food safety awareness campaign.
- 2.4 Operationalize NIVS Inspectorate, incrementally.
- 2.5 Develop Guidance on Food Labelling Practices.





- **Engage with Domestic and International Partners and Stakeholders to Promote Suriname's Position as a Leading Food and Agrifood Producer.** Activities:
- 3.1 Enable effective preparation and participation of Surinamese delegations in Codex Committee proceedings.
- 3.2 Play a leading role in the operationalization of the Caribbean Taskforce on Food Safety and support Caribbean Food Regulatory
- Convergence.







Build a Dynamic and Professional Workforce and Enable Effective

Food Regulatory Operations

Activities:

- 4.1 Recruit a vibrant and developing food regulatory workforce serving the objectives of NIVS and the food production sectors through multiple strategies and engagement with academic institutions in Suriname.
- 4.2 Develop and deploy the relevant Information and Communication Tools (ICTs) needed for the food regulatory operationalization of NIVS programs.



Build a Science Capacity Serving Stakeholders and NIVS

Activities:

5.1 Enhance food laboratory operations with extension of food testing capacities to address the needs of Suriname's food production sectors.



- 5.2 Develop a food safety science capacity to anchor NIVS Decisionmaking in Food Risk Analysis.
- 5.3 Sustain infrastructure, equipment and operational investments to support NIVS food safety regulatory operations



Next Steps / Year One Implementation

- □ Modernization of the Food Act : Policy and Possible Introduction in Parliament
- □ Initiate Modernization of Food Import Control : Risk-Based Approach
- Requirements of Operations for Food Business Operators (FBOs): Voluntary Guidance for Pre-Requisite Programs and Preventive Controls e.g. GAP – Tailored to small operations
- □ Launch of Food Safety Education Campaign: Consumers and FBOs
- Initial Review and Adoption of Horizontal Food Safety Requirements e.g. Contaminants management,
- □ IT mediated Food Inspectorate Initial Modernization of VKI Inspection Regime
- □ Guidance for Food Labelling
- Effective Participation in Codex Proceedings and leadership role in the Caribbean Food safety taskforce
- Initiate building NIVS workforce through collaborative approaches with the Academic Institutions
- Enhance Food Safety Testing Capacity : Diversification/Enhancements of VKI Food Laboratory Capacity
